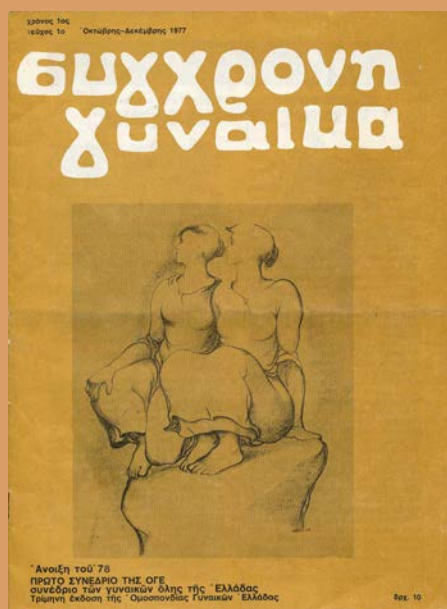


Open Window [Anihto Parathiro], issue 24, October-December 1983

The bimonthly magazine was the official publication of the Women's Union of Greece and was initially published in 1979.

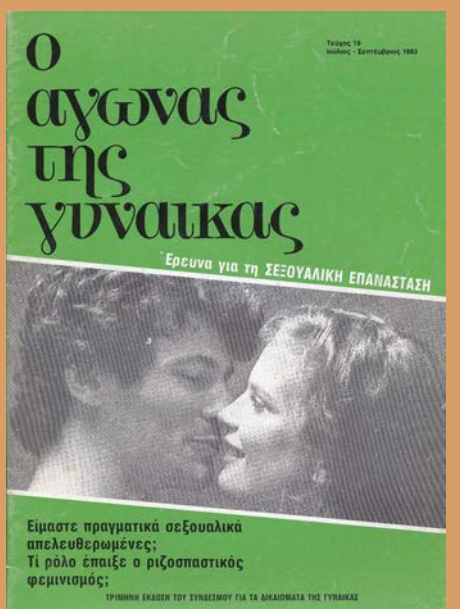
Modern Woman [Synchroni Gynaika], issue 1, October- December 1977

The magazine was a quarterly publication of the Federation of Greek Women [OGE]. It was first released in 1977.



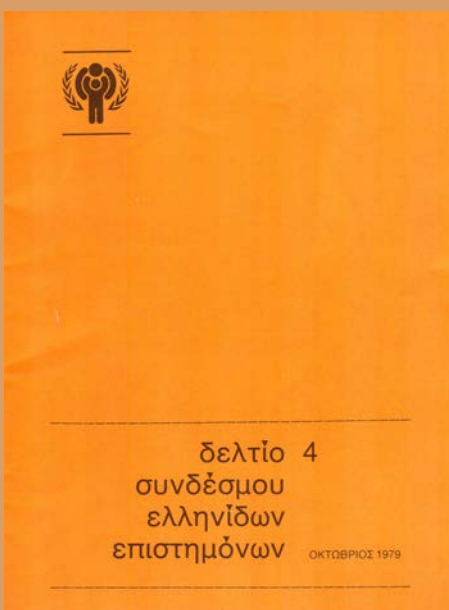
The Woman's Struggle [O agonas tis gynaikas], issue 19, July- September 1983

The historic Greek League for Women's Right was reestablished in 1974. In January 1979, it released anew, under Rena Lampsa, it's quarterly publication *Woman's Struggle*. The emblematic publication was being published from 1923 to 1936 and was strongly linked to the feministic movement of the time, defending women's rights to vote, labor and scientific training.



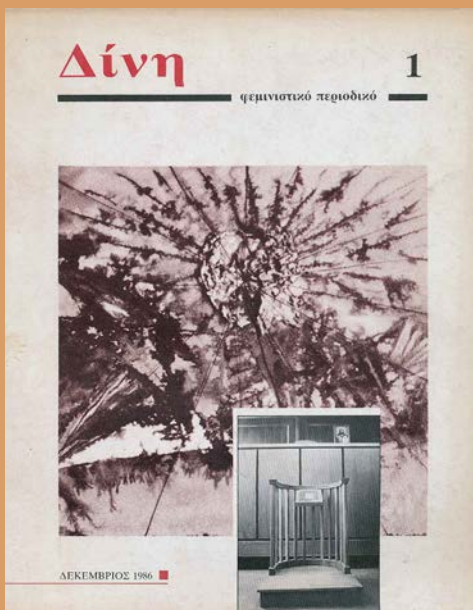
Swirling [Dini]: feminist magazine, issue 1, December 1986

The release of *Dini* strengthened the feminist turn towards women's studies, which had already started from the beginning of the decade. 8 issues of the magazine were released until 1991.



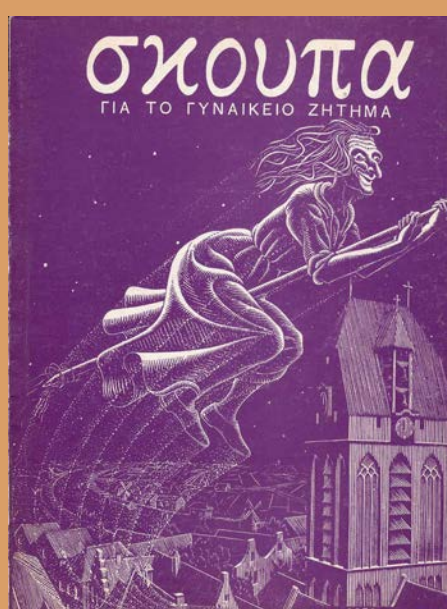
Bulletin of the Greek Women Scientists Association, issue 4, October 1979

The Greek Women Scientists Association is one of the oldest women's organizations, active since 1924. It supports women in civil services and the private sector.



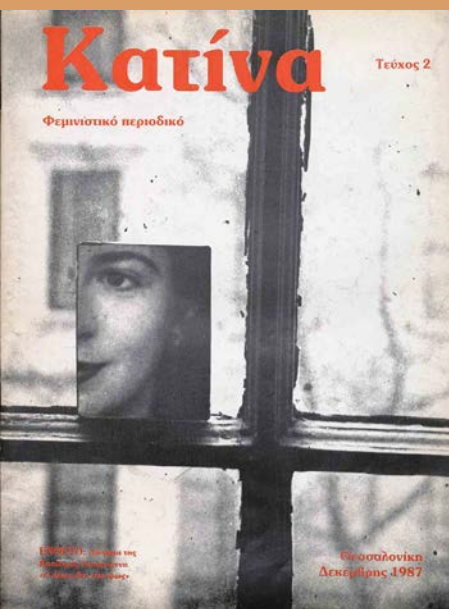
Broom for the women's movement [Skoupa gia to gynaikeio zitima], issue 1, January 1979

Broom for the women's movement was the first magazine to introduce the feminist theories that were developing in Greece at that time. From 1979 to 1981 it released 5 issues, each one in 5.000 copies.



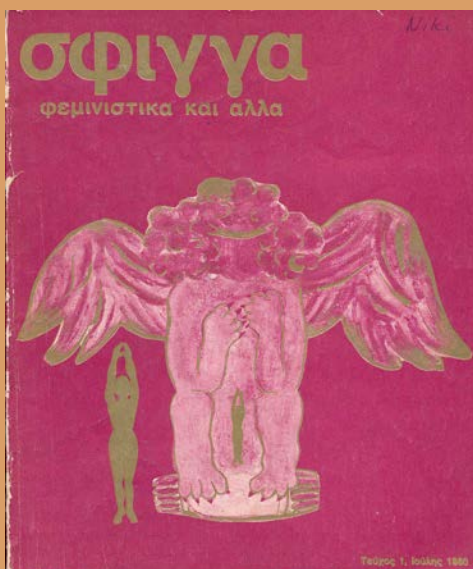
Equality and Gender, June- July 1988

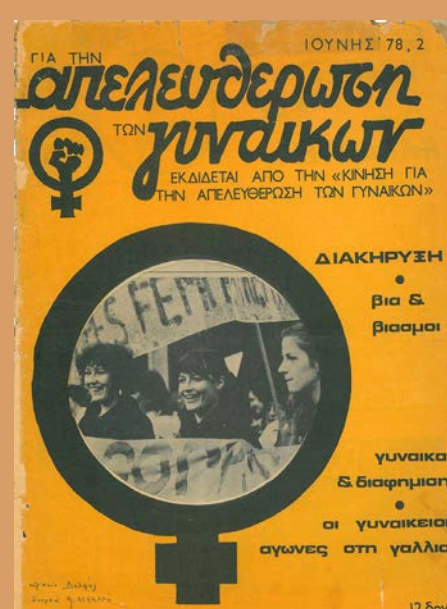
Journal issued by the Thessaloniki Autonomous Women's Group from 1987 to 1991.
